What is Summer Slam?

Summer Slam is a 4 week transition program for incoming freshmen designed to prepare them for the high school experience. Challenging curriculum includes: Language Arts, Math, History and Science with an emphasis on critical thinking skills, reading comprehension and test-taking strategies.

When is Summer Slam?

Summer Slam runs July 7-July 31, 2025 from 8:00-1:00pm, Monday through Thursday. Lunch will be provided.

Who are the teachers?

Highly qualified teachers from the Freshman Academy at Red Bank Regional High School.

Where is Summer Slam offered?: Summer Slam is offered at Red Bank Regional High School.

Students must attend all 4 weeks. Attendance is mandatory.
